

## **ADDITIONAL TRAINING POLICY**

In order to satisfy the “Additional Training” requirement of Section 1.3 of the Massachusetts Collaborative Law Council Membership Standards, members must complete at least three (3) hours of Additional Training approved by the Council in every two years subsequent to the first year of membership. The following programs may qualify for Additional Training hours (subject to approval\*):

- Annual Advanced Training/Forum (hours to be determined based on program)
- Introductory Family Law Skills Development Workshop (1 hour)
- Civil Collaborative Training (3 hours or otherwise determined by program)
- Select Members Meetings (to be announced in advance ) (1 hour)
- IACP programs (hours varied)

Each member shall receive credit hours only for complete workshop attendance.

Practice Group Meetings shall not qualify as Additional Training.

Presenters of approved programs shall qualify for credit equal to attendee credit.

\*Additional Training programs must be approved in advance by the Vice-President of Education and Training and the Membership Committee Chair, who will also confirm or establish the number of hours for which the program will qualify.
